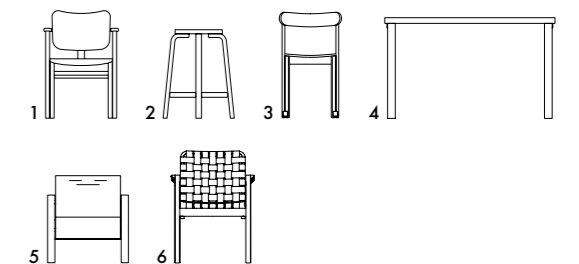


## Tech Company

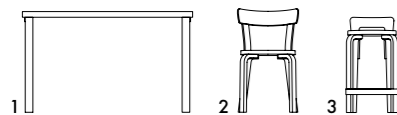


# Kurashicom Inc.

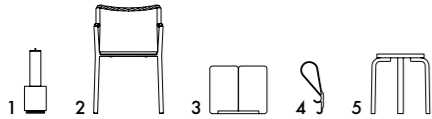

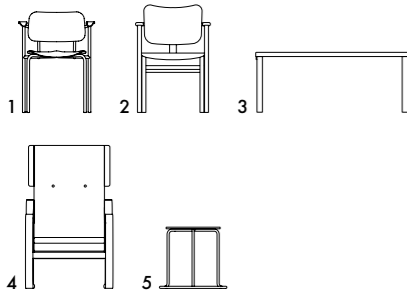
# Restaurant Töölö

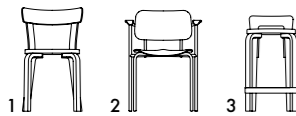

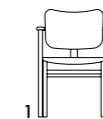

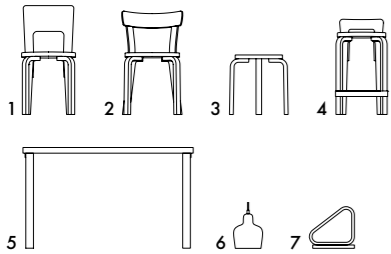


# Café Aalto by Mealdo

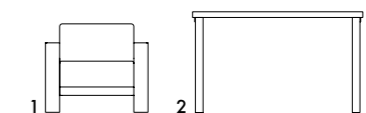
## Aalto University Harald Herlin Learning Centre

The Harald Herlin Learning Centre was designed by Artek founder Alvar Aalto and his second wife, Elissa. Serving as a library for Aalto University (named after Alvar), it was renovated and re-opened in autumn 2016 as a multifunctional and modern space.

The building showcases hallmarks of Alvar Aalto's design, including its fan-like shape and masterful use of indirect lighting. During the 2016 renovation, Artek furnished the reading area with Armchair 400 "Tank" and Aalto Tables, enhancing the historic character of the building while supporting multidisciplinary learning.



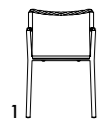

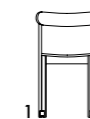


## Nationalmuseum Stockholm

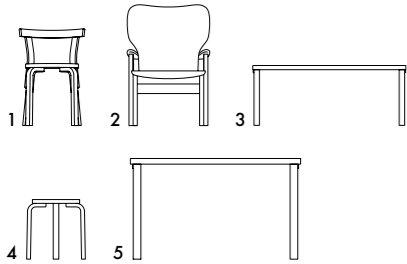

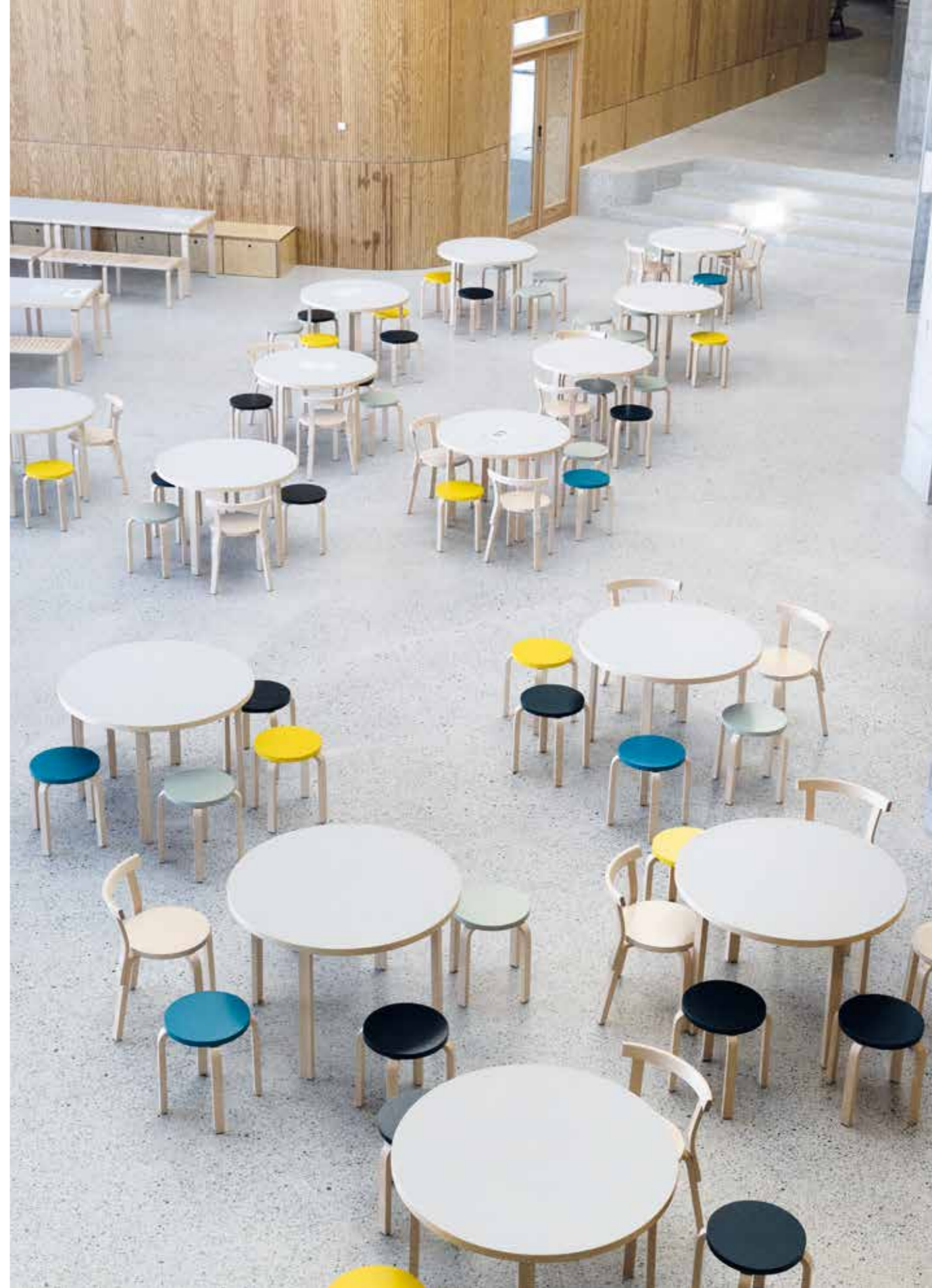


# Kalvebod Fælled School

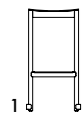


# Museum of Far Eastern Antiquities

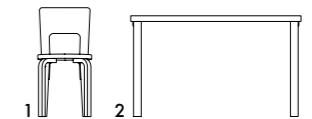


## HC Andersen House

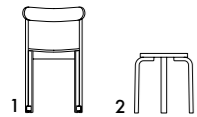

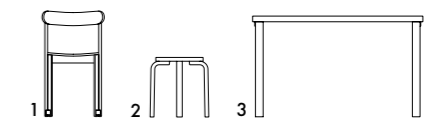


## Z33, House for Contemporary Art, Design & Architecture

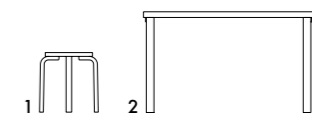


## La Biennale di Venezia
